

2010 DeMolay International Postal Match

NATIONAL AWARDS

INDIVIDUAL MATCH

An individual award for each ten (10) individuals who have competed.

TEAM MATCH

First Place: Four (4) individual awards for each ten (10) teams who have competed.

REGIONAL AWARDS ANNUAL POSTAL RIFLE MATCHES

REGION 1

Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island and Vermont.

REGION 2

Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Virginia and District of Columbia.

REGION 3

Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina and Tennessee.

REGION 4

Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Michigan, Ohio and West Virginia.

REGION 5

Iowa, Minnesota, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota and Wisconsin.

REGION 6

Arkansas, Kansas, Louisiana, Missouri, Oklahoma and Texas.

REGION 7

Arizona, Colorado, Montana, New Mexico, Utah and Wyoming.

REGION 8

Alaska, California, Hawaii, Idaho, Nevada, Oregon and Washington.

OVERSEAS REGION

All areas not included in the above regions.

Regional awards will be granted in each of the nine (9) DeMolay regions as follows:

INDIVIDUAL MATCH

1st place - Regional Champion's Trophy provided there are ten (10) individuals competing in a region.

An award for each additional 15 individuals competing in a region.

TEAM MATCH

1st place - Regional Winner's Trophy and four (4) individual awards, provided there are five (5) teams competing in a region.

Four (4) additional awards for each additional ten (10) teams competing in a region.

Note:

No competitor or team will be awarded more than one award in a match. When more than one award is won, the competitor or team will be Issued the highest award and other awards will be passed down to the next eligible competitor or team.

ELIGIBILITY

Individual Match - Open to any member of DeMolay International who is in good standing in his Chapter and who has not reached his majority on the date this match is fired.

Team Match - Open to one or more teams of four (4) shooters from each DeMolay Chapter. Team members must be in good standing in their Chapter and must not have reached their majority on the date this match is fired. Each team may have a coach. The coach may be an adult. Under no circumstances will the coach be a firing member.

No Competitor may fire more than once in the same match. An individual or team may fire in one or in all of the matches listed.

ENTRY CLOSING DATES

Entries may be made at any time provided targets can be fired and scores submitted to the NRA by January 1, 2011. No scores will be

accepted if not received or postmarked on or before January 1. You may submit scores via e-mail to: postals@nrahq.org Mail only the top 3 targets from your match to NRA. Keep all targets until 2 weeks after the scores are posted on the web, and all scores are final.

Use the entry form attached to this program, the form may be copied. When entries are received by the NRA, registered labels and score sheets will be sent to the advisor in charge.

FIRING DATES

Fired targets must be returned to the NRA, postmarked not later than January 1. Units may fire the individual match first and use these scores as a basis for selecting the team members.

COURSES OF FIRE

SMALLBORE RIFLE

In matches 1 and 2 each shooter will fire 10 shots prone, 10 shots standing, and 10 shots kneeling.

Matches 1 and 2 will be fired with .22 caliber rifles at 50 feet. (NRA Smallbore Rifle Rule 3.2).

AIR RIFLE

In matches 3 and 4 each shooter will fire 10 shots prone, 10 shots standing, and 10 shots kneeling.

Matches 3 and 4 will be fired with sporter air rifles at 10 meters. (NRA Sporter Air Rifle Rule 3.2).

DISQUALIFICATION

Your team or any individual will be disqualified for shooting on other than the A-17 Target, for smallbore rifle or the AR- 5/10 for sporter air rifle. A list of NRA targets and licensed manufacturer's is available at:

IMPORTANT NOTICE

In order to maintain the highest possible standards in all NRA sponsored or co-sponsored postal matches, the NRA reserves the right to investigate unusually high scores submitted by competitors of unknown ability (no current shoulder-to-shoulder classification on file, etc.) And to observe a firing of substantiating scores. This refiring will be accomplished on NRA registered targets in the presence of an NRA appointed witness.

Failure on the part of the competitor in individual matches or club officials in team matches to cooperate will result in disqualification. Failure to approximate the original scores when the substantiating scores are fired will result in the NRA recording only the substantiating scores.

SMALLBORE RIFLE

NRA Smallbore Rifle rules, except as modified in this program, will govern matches 1 and 2. Rule books are available from Program Materials at 1-800-336-7402. Ask for item #CR16750.

Targets A-17 targets are required and will not be provided by the NRA.

AIR RIFLE

NRA Sporter Air Rifle Position rules, except as modified in this program, will govern matches 3 and 4. Rule books are available from Program Materials at 1-800-336-7402. Ask for item #CA 16320.

Targets AR-5/10 targets are required and will not be provided by the NRA.

Smallbore & Air Rifle General Conditions

Spotting Scopes may be used.

Time limit is 1 minute for each record shot.

Sighting Shots of whatever number desired may be taken but no additional time will be allowed.

Clips or Magazines may not be used and all cartridges or pellets must be loaded singly by the shooter.

Coaching is permitted only in the team match. No coaching is permitted in the individual match.

NRA Standing Position permitted. Smallbore Rifle Rule 5.12 and Sporter Air Rifle rule 5.12.

Supervision is required during all firing and will be by a member of the chapter Advisory Council. The Supervisor will act as the Official Witness.

Target seals will not be required. Competitor is to sign his target **before firing** on the back behind the #1 bull. The A-17 target (smallbore rifle) or the AR-5/10 (air rifle) must be used. (One shot per bull).

Each target must contain shooter name, and the firing position.

SCORE REPORT SHEET please be sure to read and complete the score sheet correctly. The most overlooked item is the name of the postal. Also be sure to indicate if the scores are for a team or individual match.
